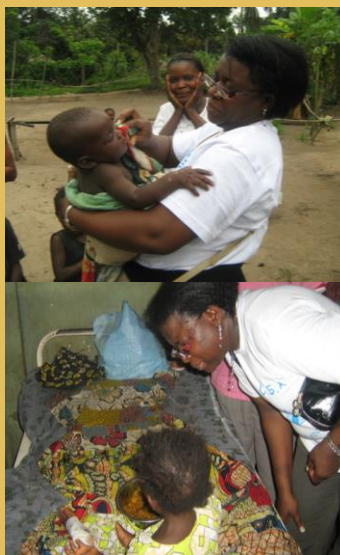


WHAT WE DO FOR PEOPLE NEEDS

- Drinking water project : managing the springs. The objective of this project is to reduce water-related diseases by cleaning and managing one of the spring waters. LVM hired professional water experts to do an extensive need assessment
- Education project: Mama Rose program and Library. This program offers scholarships to needy children. Since 2001, Mama Rose has been working with (a) unwed mothers who cannot afford to send their kids to school, and (b) orphans. We sponsor about 25 kids per year.
- Activity and Communication Center project (Youth). There is a tremendous need of a community computer center to afford internet access, telephone, and computer availability.
- Agriculture project: building a sustainable food system. Luila Village Ministries (LVM) will bring together women and out-of-school youth from diverse backgrounds to build a sustainable food system in the village of Luila in Congo DRC.

WHAT WE DO WE NEED YOUR HELP

- Health project: children hospital. The initial phase calls for the facility to have: an entrance area with a waiting room, an emergency room, 16 hospital rooms with 2 beds per room (32 patients in the first phase); a training room and a cafeteria; a multipurpose room.
- Evangelism out of comfort zone project. There is a tremendous need of revival for adults who have never really attended a Church and to evangelize the youth. Less than 10% of the villagers possess a Bible. More than 67% of women become mothers in adolescence and to support their homes become prostitute.
- Worldwide Evangelism and Mission Trips
- Light and reading glasses project.
